- Seek out the Big Five in Ngorongoro Crater, a natural amphitheater with a rich concentration of wildlife.
- Visit a coffee plantation in Arusha and learn about the process and history of coffee production in the region.
- Stay in comfortable, strategically located tented camps to maximize your safari experience.
- Witness magnificent Victoria Falls, the world's largest waterfall.

ITINERARY

BLD = BREAKFAST, LUNCH, DINNER

JUNE 14 - USA

Depart United States and fly overnight to Tanzania.

JUNE 15 - ARUSHA

Upon arrival to Kilimanjaro International Airport, a Holbrook representative will meet you outside of the airport and transfer you to Arusha Coffee Lodge. The lodge is hidden amongst one of Tanzania's largest coffee plantations and consists of 30 plantation houses designed around the original landowner's home, dating back to the early 1900s. Please note: this is an arrival day and no meals are included. *Overnight at Arusha Coffee Lodge.*

JUNE 16 - SERENGETI

Start today with a tour of the coffee plantation. As you explore the plantation, your coffee guide will explain how the bean is nurtured, harvested, dried, and finally roasted to produce myriad different blends. Afterwards, transfer to the airport for your flight to Serengeti National Park. Upon arrival, head to Kichakani Serengeti Camp, with wildlife viewing along the way. Kichakani features luxury tents with a wooden deck, ensuite bathrooms, and comfortable beds. Sanctuary Kichakani Serengeti Camp's two set locations throughout the year are based on the natural migration path, offering wildlife viewing from open plains, sweeping grasslands and rocky kopjes. The stars of this seasonal path are wildebeest, zebra, Thomson's gazelles, and the predators that this migratory journey attracts. After lunch, enjoy a game drive in the park. *Overnight at Sanctuary Kichakani Camp. (BLD)*

JUNE 17 - SERENGETI

Early this morning, you have the option to take a balloon safari over the Serengeti. This once-in-a-lifetime experience offers a bird's eye view of the plains below that you cannot get from the ground. If not on the balloon safari, start the day with a game drive in the park. Serengeti National Park is a UNESCO World Heritage Site where over a million wildebeest famously migrate every year. It is known for having the Big Five; cheetahs are also a highlight, along with wild dog, giraffe, waterbuck, zebra, gazelle, buffalo, and elephant, as well as predators like lion and leopard. Return to camp for lunch and time to relax, then enjoy a late afternoon safari followed by a sundowner before dinner. *Overnight at Sanctuary Kichakani Camp. (BLD)*

JUNE 18 - NGORONGORO CRATER

After breakfast, take one more game drive and then depart for Ngorongoro Crater and Ngorongoro Sopa Safari Lodge. The lodge is located on the on the crater rim, and all rooms have a balcony offering beautiful views of the crater far below. After a late lunch, the remainder of the day will be free to relax and enjoy the amazing views or take a walk around the lodge and crater rim. *Overnight at Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge. (BLD)*

JUNE 19 - NGORONGORO CRATER

This morning, descend into Ngorongoro Crater for a game drive among one of the most unique concentrations of wildlife on earth. Vast grasslands cover most of the crater floor and provide ample grazing for resident zebras, gazelles, wildebeest, elephants, warthogs, and rhinos. With a large number of prey species contained within the crater, it is not surprising that Ngorongoro is also home to a dense population of lions. During your game drive you will enjoy a picnic lunch before returning to the lodge for some time to relax. Later in the afternoon you will again descend into the crater for another game drive. *Overnight at Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge. (BLD)*

JUNE 20 - TARANGIRE

This morning head to Tarangire National Park and Ndovu Tented Lodge located in the heart of the park. The camp consists of 12 permanent tents set on wooden platforms, that include a balcony, comfortable bed and en suite bathroom. After lunch have time to relax or take a swim in the pool while being on the lookout for wildlife. *Overnight at Ndovu Tented Lodge. (BLD)*

JUNE 21 - TARANGIRE

This morning embark on a game drive in Tarangire National Park. The Tarangire River snakes through the park; as it's the area's only permanent river, wildlife travel long distances to reach it. The 1,096 square miles of protected lands are home to a large variety of game, such as wildebeests, zebras, gazelles, elands, gerenuks, lion, leopards and large herds of elephant. Extensive grasslands, dotted with the occasional acacia or baobab tree, provide the optimum conditions for viewing wild animals. Birding enthusiasts will have the opportunity to see more than 500 avian species, including Yellow-collared Lovebirds, Rufous-tailed Weavers, Ashy Starlings, Stocking-thighed Ostriches, and Kori Bustards. After lunch at the lodge, have time to relax at the pool. Later in the day you will take another game drive in the park. *Overnight at Ndovu Tented Lodge. (BLD)*

JUNE 22 - ARUSHA-ADDIS ABABA

Head back to Arusha today. Visit Ilboru Primary School, the first primary school in Tanzania specially designed to meet the needs of deaf and disabled children. During your visit you will learn about their programs, plus meet teachers and students. Then, transfer to Arusha Coffee Lodge, where you will have a room to freshen up, rest, and prepare for your flight to Addis Ababa (the connection to Victoria Falls). In the early evening, head to the Kilimanjaro Airport and take the flight to Addis Ababa (covered by Ethiopian Air). *Day room at Arusha Coffee Lodge and overnight at Addis Ababa airport hotel. (BLD)*

JUNE 23 - VICTORIA FALLS, ZIMBABWE

Upon arrival in the Victoria Falls Airport you will be met and taken to the Victoria Falls Lodge. With a glorious pedigree dating back to 1904, The Victoria Falls Hotel features 161 rooms and suites — truly a five-star experience of pure grandeur. This evening enjoy a dinner cruise on the Zambezi River. *Overnight at Victoria Falls Hotel. (D)*

JUNE 24 - VICTORIA FALLS, ZIMBABWE

This morning, we'll enjoy a walking safari in Zambezi National Park, upstream of the falls. Afterwards visit the massive Victoria Falls for an exploration of this wonder of the world. The remainder of the afternoon will be at leisure to relax or explore on your own. *Overnight at Victoria Falls Hotel. (B)*

JUNE 25 - DEPART

The morning will be at leisure before transferring to the airport for your flight home. *(B)*

JUNE 26 - ARRIVE U.S.

Arrive home.
